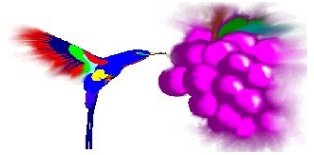

CHATEAU LA TOUR DE MONS

Cru Bourgeois

The Château La Tour de Mons is a single block vineyard, located in the northern part of the Margaux appellation, on the banks of the Garonne, as the best Médoc Crus. The origin of the château dates back to the 13th century. Amongst its illustrious owners was Pierre de Mons, who acquired the property in 1623 and gave it his name. The estate belonged to his lineage until the end of the 20th century.

Since the 1990's, the new owners of the château have implemented major renovations to the wine making facility, and vineyard through a large vineyard drainage program, and vineyard management focused on sustainable ecological balance.

MARQUIS DE MONS (2nd Label of Ch Latour de Mons)

Appellation: Margaux

Vineyard: 48 Ha, 10-35 Yr. old vines on sandy loam soils.

Grape: Merlot 55%, Cabernet Sauvignon 41%. Petit Verdot 4%.

Harvest: By hand.

Vinification: De-stemming, cold maceration, crushing, 24 Days Temp-controlled fermentation.

Aging: 18 Mo. in French oak barrels.

Production: 800-1,400 Cases.
