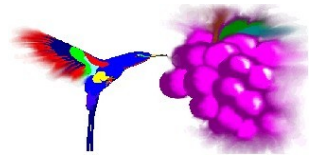

CHÂTEAU PATRIS **Saint-Émilion Grand Cru**

Acquired in 1967 by the present owners, Geneviève and Michel Querre, Château Patris is located on the Southern side of the Saint-Émilion slopes in a continuation of the vineyards of Château Angélus.

The cultural practices leave nothing to chance and the same requirement prevails in the vineyard as in the cellar. Manual harvesting in small crates makes it possible to obtain and guarantee an irreproachable fruit in terms of quality. Michel and Geneviève QUERRE and their team are looking to produce a deep Saint-Émilion, with a velvety but well-structured texture.

Saint-Émilion Grand Cru Rouge

Appellation: Saint-Émilion.

Vineyard(s): 9 Ha, facing SW, sandy, with sandy-clay sub-soil, Guyot-simple vine training.

Grape(s): Cabernet Franc (10%) Cabernet Sauvignon (10%) Merlot (80%).

Harvest: By hand.

Vinification: De-stemming, temperature-controlled cold fermentation with local yeasts, 18 days/24° C, bottled un-filtered & un-fined.

Aging: 60% New barrels, 40% 2nd use barrels.

Production: 2,000 Cases/Year.
