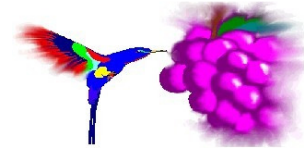

CHATEAU CAILLET

The vineyard is located in Segonzac, a tiny farming community about 70 miles NNE of Bordeaux, and just 10 miles ESE of the famed town of Cognac. The area enjoys temperate days (from uninterrupted N. Atlantic weather patterns sweeping in from the West), with cooler evening temperatures. This allows for good grape skin development, with complex, smooth tannin, and deeply colored reds.

BORDEAUX ROUGE

Appellation: Bordeaux.

Vineyard: 10 Ha. Segonzac, clay-limestone

Grape(s): Merlot Noir (55%), Cabernet Franc (35%), Cabernet Sauvignon (10%)

Harvest: By hand.

Vinification: De-stemming, temperature-controlled fermentation, 20 days/23° C.

Aging: Oak-Free. 1,000 Cases/vintage labeled.

Foods: Beef, lamb, game, hearty dishes, sausages, grilled/blackened tuna, hearty Bolognese pastas, and strong cheese.

Descriptive: A classic Bordeaux, with spicy currant-plum, earthy. Very smooth, well balanced, fine tannin, and medium-long finish
